Young people on interim accommodation orders and family preservation orders are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for Better Futures.

If the young person moves to another region, their Better Futures and Home Stretch support and funding moves with them.

*A young person may not be eligible for ongoing Home Stretch funding if they choose to return to their family of origin.
